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**Regional jet market set for expansion**

More than 3,380 regional aircraft worth around \$80 billion will be produced over the next ten years.

A recently released study by Forecast International, called "The World Market for Regional Transport Aircraft", estimates that the demand for regional airliners that seat 70, 90 or 120 passengers is set to increase between 2005 and 2014.

The report also predicts that 2,731 jet-powered regional aircraft and 650 turboprops will be produced during the 10-year timeframe.

Continuing traffic growth and the easing of scope clause restrictions are among the factors driving this trend, the report has suggested.

Bombardier and Embraer are currently two of the dominant players in the regional aircraft market. Embraer plans to produce the 94 -106 seat Embraer 190 and 106-118 seat Embraer 195. While Bombardier is proposing its CSeries family of aircraft that would cover the 110-130 seat market.
